Secondary Squamous Ulceration--This type of ulceration is rarely seen in horses older than one year of age and is associated with gastroduodenal ulcer disease (GDUD), where the primary lesion is found in the duodenum Clinical signs include watery diarrhea, refusal to nurse, mild colic, and/ or teeth grinding

Freeze Branding Horses - Texas A&M AgriLife

This is the step-by-step procedure for freeze branding horses: 1 Chill the irons to -300 degrees F in the container of liquid nitrogen The surface of the nitrogen will appear as pinhead size bubbles (boiling action has stopped) when the irons are chilled to -300 degrees F and they are ready for use Place the container
